Stop the Sound!

Now you have learned how to make the bell ring. How do you make it stop? How do I make the short stopped sounds asked for in the music? This class will teach the techniques for short and stopped sounds utilizing mallets, table pads, and even yourself!

4-In-Hand Is a Solution

Playing 4 bells in two hands is usually seen in the high treble bells in most choirs. Choirs struggling to fill positions could use this technique to fill two positions. Even ringers in the middle bells can use this technique to help play accidentals. You will learn the basic 4 in hand techniques and see how they might be able to help your choir.

Drum Circle

Learn how to become part of a rhythmic community! Drum circle will teach you the art of listening to each other, making music with a beat as a group, and it's fun!!
